Mission and Belief:

Knowledge empowers and Happiness heals!

Samiksha Foundation provides **non-medical** support to children undergoing treatment for cancer and other life-limiting illness in Pediatric hospitals, increasing their Happiness Quotient through learning and creative activity, facilitating their return to mainstream life.

- Areas of action:
 - Educational support provided by trained teachers and tutor volunteers
 - Spiritual support through yoga and creative visualization
 - Creative play and activity
- Focus group: children between 4 and 16 years and women from compromised socio-economic sections of society in India affected by cancer
- Scholarship for survivors: Post-treatment, help the child return to school in the right grade with confidence and dignity, and support their higher education
- Impact: Until February 2025, formal education during treatment for over **15076** children; awarded **526** scholarships for continued education post-treatment.

- 2008 Founded by Ar. Sandhya Sharad in Bengaluru, India
- 2009 Non-profit trust registered with 2 trustees First learning centre at the Kapur Ward, Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology, Bengaluru Dr. Manjari Bhatnagar joins as Director and Ms. Vidyavathi as the first teacher
- 2017 FCRA certificate Obtained valid until October 2028
- 2019 Started at Mazumdar Shaw Cancer Center, Narayana Health City, Bengaluru
- 2020 Covid support and Pivoted to Samiksha 2.0 hybrid learning model, launched Samiksha USky digital learning platform
- 2022 3 new learning centres added at Bangalore
- Started at St John's Hospital 'Unit of HOPE'
 Currently,- Full set up at 4 hospital centers and 2 remote.
 Now supporting Nephrology and Thalassemia children

- Digital Learning Platform

















526 students have received awards, at a total value of over **Rs 78 lakhs till January 2025**.


Snapshot:

CORPORATE ASK:

• Child Support Costs: ₹6,536 per child annually, or ₹545 per month, providing educational, spiritual, and creative play support during their 6–9-month treatment journey.

• Learning Centre Operations: ₹11 lakh annually to fund one learning centre- 200 paediatric inpatient beneficiaries including teacher's salaries and volunteer support costs OR (\$14,000 for 200 paediatric inpatient beneficiaries).

• Scholarships: About ₹15 lakh (\$17,700) annually to fund at least 60 scholarships towards high school and college student education ; INR 25,000/- (\$301) for 1 scholarship for college students fees

• **Developing and improving Infrastructure**: ₹6.5 lakh to develop our remote mentoring and Digital infrastructure at CoE;

Enable us to set up a training facility at Pune in 2025

• Arrange fund raising events and awareness workshops : Sponsor / Organize a cultural event to spread awareness and raise funds for admin and running expenses of the Trust - Target 15 lakhs per year
